**Short Study Description** (repeat from Study Group Proposal):  
Spacearts – the Space Art Database

**Spacearts** is an online database providing information about art related to outer space since the middle of the 19th century until the present.

**Spacearts** is designed to be a comprehensive database that focuses on the artists engaged with the themes of outer space exploration and development and documents their significant contributions.

**Spacearts** will be international in scope and multilingual in practice with English, French and German language versions developed simultaneously.

The content of **Spacearts** is being be curated. It is open to public submission and each record is evaluated and edited before being added to the publicly accessible database

**Progress in past six months:**

The core team has been developing proposals for seeking additional funding. A second mirror site was set-up ([www.spacearts.org](http://www.spacearts.org)) A new programmer has been given access to the development website in order to develop new features.
