Space Traffic Management Working Group

- Being chaired by Dr. Mark Skinner – just getting started – assembling members
- Terms of Reference (23 February 2018)
 - Background: The IAASS (“the Association”) has initiated a technical working group (WG) to explore some of the aspects of Space Traffic Management (STM), and report back to the Association with the findings.
 - Specifically, the Association would like to empanel a selection of international STM experts:
 - What are the main activities going on now (or planned for the near future), and who is involved?
 - What standards and/or rules, guidelines, etc., should be developed (and agreed upon) at an *international* level?
 - Compile a listing of commercially available STM services.
- The desired output is a broad overview report that addresses these questions, to be presented at the 2019 IAASS meeting in Los Angeles.
- Hold a series of telephone meetings (of order 6 or so), at which the experts can give short-to-medium length presentations (15-25 minutes in length), with any charts being distributed in advance, and with questions and group discussion to follow the presentation.
 - The charts and notes from the group discussion will form the basis for the content of the report back to the Association. Group members are also welcome to contribute additional content to be included in an appendix to the report.
